Biblical Resolution C1603 Ekklesia Convocations

We the citizens of the Kingdom Congress, as a representative ekklesia for the citizens of the State of Illinois, do acknowledge that there is only one true and living God who is the Maker of heaven and earth and that this great God has elected to covenant with men in the administration of the earth to the end that the earth would be glorified and He would be honored, and

Whereas, we do realize that God has poured out blessings and grace upon his church by granting us forgiveness of sins and has opened to us an eternal covenant, and

Whereas, we confess that we have sinned and fallen short of the grace of God for which we offer repentance and request that we be forgiven by the efficacious atonement for sin offered by Jesus Christ and, through his atonement, have been granted a standing in grace, and

Whereas, we acknowledge that God has offered us a covenant through Jesus Christ, which secures our relationship with the Godhead in this life and that life which is to come, and that contained in that covenant are rights, privileges and responsibilities, and

Whereas, we recognize that Jesus Christ did establish His church as a called out legislative body, did grant His ekklesia authority to use the keys of the kingdom, and did empower that convocation to bind sin and loose righteous.

Therefore, we do accept the assignment of the covenant to represent the kingdom as ambassadors, and to manage the kingdom as the ekklesia unto the goal of discipling the nations and legislating God's eternal will into the earth.

Therefore, we do petition the Almighty to bless and establish His ekklesia in the state of Illinois by way of His covenant keeping faithfulness and the obedience of the ekklesia to fulfill Christ's mandate; that laboring together His righteous ways might fill this state, transform culture, reveal His glory, and expand the influence of the ekklesia of Illinois beyond the borders of the state into the earth.
